Please do not overstate the number of patients you have seen. For example: if you see an acne patient seven times during a residency year that would count as one patient not seven. If you see that same patient next year, he may be counted once again on next year's list. A patient with four warts treated would count as one patient, not four. If this same patient also had multiple skin tags removed at the same visit, he may be counted also as a skin tag patient.
