Explanatory Statement: This recommendation for funding is based upon the actions taken in the April 25, 2009 meetings of the Council on Research and the Review Committee of the Council on Research. Total funding recommended for is **\$569,031** for grants and **\$30,000** for fellowships (see additional resolution) for a total of **\$599,031** for Fiscal Year 2010. The AOA ORDF will fund **\$300,000**; the Osteopathic Heritage Foundation will provide matching funds of **\$299,031**.
